- How does your program promote active citizenship within the program, on campus and in the community?
- What is the number one reason you feel your program should be the 2010 Break Away Chapter Program of the Year?

*The complete application should not exceed 22 pages (that number does not include the Program of the Year nomination form and Host Site recommendation). They can be single or double spaced and must be in 10 - 12 font.

- After the Awards process, I would be willing to share the information and documents included in this application with the national alternative break movement.
