You will venture into the rice fields of the Svay Ring province, learn about the continuing implications of the recent genocide and gain a deeper understanding of the role clean water plays in transforming communities. Whether sharing about the importance of hygiene and sanitation or digging wells and building latrines, you will see Cambodia from the capital city of Phnom Penh to the rural farms and come to share the lives of these people a world away.

When you travel to the DR, you and your group will stay at the Wine To Water ceramic water filter factory and have a direct hand in creating these life-saving filters. Then you will connect with the families that have benefited from having clean water in their homes and see the transformation first-hand.

## ■ E T H I O P I A

Return to your origin with a visit to Ethiopia, commonly called the cradle of civilization. Biblically known as the land of Cush and Abyssinia, Ethiopia is the only country in Africa that was never colonized partly because of its impressive mountains and vast lowland deserts. This land of contrast is one of the poorest countries on the planet leaving almost half the population without access to safe drinking water. Be prepared for your own transformation as you construct wells in the Great Rift Valley with people who are materialistically poor but rich in spirit. The contrast is overwhelming for those open to a cultural adventure and simultaneously learning about the water crisis.

Whether constructing rainwater harvest tanks, making bio-sand filters or digging wells, you will witness the process of reconstruction alongside these wonderful, resilient people.
